

How to Dispose of Garbage and Recyclable Waste

Notes on Putting Garbage Out for Collection

- Place your garbage and recyclable waste at the collection site by 8:00 am on the collection day.
- Burnable waste and recyclable waste must be placed in their respective designated bags. There are no designated bags for hazardous waste, but please sort out batteries, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, spray cans, and lighters, and put them out separately.
- ** Recyclable Waste (PET/Plastics only) bags can only be used for PET bottles and plastics. They cannot be used for cans, glass bottles and non-burnable waste. (See page on Recyclable Waste)
- Always tie bags closed without using tape or string. Items sticking out of a bag, or covered with two bags, cannot be collected; please dispose of them as bulky waste. (See page on Non-burnable Waste)






Notes on Bringing Garbage to the Recycling Plaza


- 1 Referring to the above "Notes on Putting Garbage Out for Collection", separate your bulky waste that is too big for the designated bags from your other garbage that goes into the designated bags. (See relevant pages)
- 2 Bulky waste, for which a fee is charged, and garbage in designated bags, for which no fee is charged, will be weighed separately.
 - Refer to the diagram below when loading on your vehicle, so that your garbage can be unloaded smoothly.
- 3 Bring your garbage on a vehicle less than 6 meters long and in loads of no more than 2 tons.

 Do not use a large truck or tarpaulin-covered truck such as those used for moving home, and do not pile your garbage up too high.
- 4 Garbage must be unloaded by the person who brings it in.

 If it is difficult to unload alone, please bring a second person.
- 5 Show your driver's license or other ID when you arrive.
- 6 Unloading times are from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.

Bring your garbage in a vehicle less than 6 meters long and in a load of no more than 2 tons. Do not use a large truck and do not pile your garbage up too high.





The person who brings in garbage must unload it. Please come prepared for that.

(1) Proxy

Garbage is often brought in on behalf of the person disposing of it. We will check this, so wherever possible, the person disposing of the garbage should attend too.


(2) Contractor

Garbage may only be brought to the Recycling Plaza by a contractor that has a collection and transportation permit from the municipal government.

To have a contractor bring in your garbage, you must ask the relevant section of the municipal government about licensed contractors.

%Note!

Put burnable waste and recyclable waste in their designated bags and separate them from bulky waste.





Never put metal or other non-burnable items inside!







Leaves and pruned branches


Branches must be no thicker than 3 cm.



Zippers and buttons may be left on



If metal fittings cannot be removed from a bag, etc., dispose of it as non-burnable waste.



Long or wide items

Cut long items into pieces of 50 cm or less. Cut wide items into pieces of 1 square meter or less.




Cool packs, disposable heat pads, cooking oil

(Harden oil or soak it onto paper or cloth)


Video tapes, cassette tapes, CDs, game software, floopy discs

Drain as much as possible.



Paper

Put as much used paper out for local resource collection as possible.



Aluminum wrap

Dispose of aluminum wrap and other thin aluminum waste as burnable waste.



Plastics Always put out in (Recyclable Waste) bags designated for recyclable waste or bags for PET/plastics.

Plastic food containers should be washed and dried before putting out on plastics day.

- Plastics that are difficult to separate may be put with burnable waste.
- Hangers and futon compression bags with the plastic mark should be disposed of as burnable waste.



Caps, labels

The "Plastic" mark cannot be printed on small items such as caps, so the label or other part of the product will indicate what is plastic.

Containers

Wrapping used for packaging

bags designated for recyclable waste or bags for PET/plastics.

%Note! Do not double-bag PET bottles.






For beverage bottles with the PET mark remove the lid, remove the contents, rinse, and separate as PET bottles.

If a handle is attached, it may be left on.


****Note!** Do not double-bag cans or glass bottles.

Cooking oil cans Food cans (The lids are non-burnable waste.)





Paint/ Oil cans

Empty the contents and allow to dry before putting out. Paint cans may be put out as long as the paint is dry enough not to pour out.




Sweet tins (Including lid)

2 Glass bottles

For food and beverage bottles and jars, remove the caps, empty the contents, and rinse the inside with water before separating them into bottles.

Cosmetics bottles may also be put out so long as they are clean and not made of milky white glass.







Beverage bottles



Cooking oil bottles, condiment bottles

Glass bottles for liquid medicine may be included with beverage bottles. Their caps should be separated into plastics and nonburnable depending on their materials.

Types of recyclable waste bags and how to use them





May be used for non-burnable waste, cans, glass bottles, PET bottles, and plastics (All categories of recyclable waste)

Ti Hazardous Waste









There are no designated bags, but please sort out batteries,

fluorescent tubes, mercury thermometers and blood pressure meters, spray cans, and lighters, and put them out separately.

%Note!

Do not put them out together in the same bag or container. Fluorescent tubes may be put out in their original packaging.





Dry battery and button battery **Battery for cellphone and PC**





Spray cans and lighters should be used up as much as possible. Also, spray cans must not be punctured. Caps may be left on.



Always put out in

bags designated for recyclable waste.

Sharp items such as knives and broken glass may be wrapped in paper or double-bagged. *Note! Small home appliances, metals, glass and ceramics may be put in the same designated bags, but please separate them as much as possible. Tie bags tightly.

Non-burnable Small home appliances, metals, glass, and ceramics are non-burnable. Please put them out separately as much as possible. Waste

Metals/Small Home Appliances



Mixed items containing metals (Remove batteries and put out with hazardous waste.)



18-liter cans



Umbrellas will stick out of the bag. Please tie together the parts that stick out.







An appliance that fits into a designated bag may be put into the bag as it is. Do not disassemble it. If the appliance is too big to be able to tie the bag shut, it is considered bulky waste.

There is a collection service for computers and other small home appliances. Please make use of this too.



Glass/Ceramic

Overfilling the bag will cause it to tear. Fill it so that it can be lifted with one hand.



If the pieces are not sharp, there is no need to wrap them in paper.




Plant pots (Pots that fit in a designated waste bag)



Glass bottles other than for food and beverages

(Cosmetics bottles not made of milky white glass may be put out with glass bottles)




(LED bulbs, glow bulbs, etc.)

Anything that does not fit into a recyclable waste bag should be brought in as bulky waste! Items described below will not be collected.

Tie bags tightly.





An item sticking out of a bag, or covered with two bags, cannot be collected.



Even if an item fits in a bag, it cannot be collected if the bag is taped closed or tied closed with string.




Large items that do not fit into the designated waste bags are considered bulky waste. A processing fee of \mathref{\pmathref{100}} per 10 kg is charged.

*Note! in yo

If you require a contractor to bring in your bulky waste, contact the municipal government beforehand for a list of licensed contractors.

Wooden items (Please remove glass or mirrors from furniture as much as possible.)

Lumber or other construction waste cannot be processed as bulky waste.












(Cut long items or wide items such as corrugated iron into 1.5 m pieces.)

(Be sure to disconnect fuel or batteries from heaters, etc.)





Microwave ovens






Bulky waste must be brought in intact and not disassembled.



Lights
(Be sure to unplug light bulbs or fluorescent tubes.)







Dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc. may contain a CFC refrigerant. If so, please have the CFC removed at an electronics store, etc. and bring it in together with a removal certificate. Example: HFC-134a with C is subject to this requirement.




Some items classified as industrial waste are brought in during cleanups, etc.



Main items classified as industrial waste

- Trade tools used in the past

- Seedling boxes, cloth crop covers, etc. from professional farms

• Items from a business's renovation work → Ask the construction contractor to take them away

Example: Built-in kitchen units, dishwashers, tatami mats, etc. replaced by the business











Used paper brought in without being placed in a designated waste bag will be considered bulky waste.

Designated home appliances (Also applies to components/ accessories included with such appliances)









***Note! Never disassemble appliances before disposal. (Home Appliance Recycling Act)**


Designated home appliances cannot be treated as waste by law. Talk to your appliance dealer, or purchase a recycling ticket at a post office and bring it to your nearest office.


Equipment with engines, and their associated items (Consult your dealer, etc. without disassembling the item.)








Oil (Not for cooking)

Fire extinguishers and other cylinders




Powerful drugs, hazardous materials
